Brain Infection Causes

Brain infections are thankfully rare, but they do occur. There are numerous ways that brain infections may occur. Because they are so severe and life-threatening, it's important that if you or a loved one experiences such an infection, you consider *how* the infection originated.

Unfortunately, the source of serious brain infections is often the cause of someone else's negligence. For example, here are some common causes of brain infections:


- Being in contact with cat feces
- Being bitten by a rabid animal
- Being in an unclean hospital facility where bacteria or viruses spread
- Being medically treated with equipment that facilitated the transfer of bacteria or viruses
- Consuming undercooked meat
- Consuming unwashed vegetables

In all of these situations, negligence could be a factor, which is grounds for taking a personal injury case to court and seeking damages.

For example, if someone was bitten by a rabid animal that belonged to a neighbor, and it caused a brain infection, they could seek compensation from the owner of that animal. Likewise, unwashed veggies and undercooked meat being served at a restaurant are grounds for negligence if it causes serious medical conditions, such as brain infections. Finally, hospitals are liable for damages if their negligence causes the spread of bacteria and viruses and causes a brain infection.

It is essential to diagnose a brain infection right away — whether it is viral or bacterial. Often, the first 48 hours are the most crucial. ***If left untreated, a serious brain infection can cause stroke, paralysis, or even death.*** For this reason, when considering a brain infection personal injury case, it is also important to consider whether you or your loved one was

diagnosed **correctly** and **in time** to do something about it. A diagnosing medical professional may be responsible for you or your loved one's further health damage or death if a brain injury was initially misdiagnosed.
