- Construction sites not properly marked

- Forklift accident
- Scaffold accident

## California Construction Site Injury Laws

---

Construction sites are among the most dangerous places to work and injuries while at work on these sites are common. However, pedestrians, people driving past a construction site, and bystanders may also be injured, typically, through no fault of their own. ***More than 100 innocent people who do not work on construction sites are killed each year in the United States due to construction site accidents, and many more are injured.***

Falling objects are the most common cause of construction site accidents for people who do not work there. This is almost always the result of ***negligence, usually on the part of the construction worker and/or their employer.*** Because some construction projects take place in highly populated areas, the companies that do the building are ***supposed to put measures into place to protect pedestrians and bystanders.*** However, they do not always do this or do not do it to a competent degree.

Most pedestrians and innocent bystanders who are injured on construction sites file personal injury claims with negligence being claimed on the worker and the employer. ***If a piece of defective machinery caused their injury, product liability will be filed against the manufacturer of the offending machine.***

When a pedestrian or bystander is injured because of a construction site, any party involved in that construction project is held legally responsible, including workers, contractors, sub-contractors, and property owners. If faulty machinery is being used, if careless workers are employed, and if all necessary protections for the general public (such as cones, fencing, signs, and safety walks) are not on a construction site, this may be considered negligent. This opens up any person or business entity involved in the accident to a liability claim and a personal injury lawsuit by the person who was injured.
