California DUI Statistics

Data provided by [Mothers Against Drunk Driving \(MADD\)](#) shows that **drunk drivers cause 29 percent of all traffic related fatalities**. Further, more than 300,000 intoxicated individuals go behind the wheel each day. These alarming statistics go to show that the problem of drunk driving is a serious issue. Most of the drunk drivers have made this reckless behavior a habit. It is estimated that a drunk driver can perform this felony [more than 80 times before their first arrest](#). Information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration shows that about [one in every three drivers arrested for DWI is a repeat offender](#).

California Law in Matters Concerning DUI with Injury

Any person who causes an accident in California due to intoxication of alcohol or drugs is regarded as negligent. Although criminal law dictates punishments for the careless drivers to protect from future incidences, it usually offers very little comfort to the victims of these acts who endure serious pain and injury or those who are robbed of a loved one. Even when the victims are owed compensation, it's never a match for the loss of a loved one. The pain and emotional cost endured by the victims almost always surpasses the compensatory package. Drivers who cause accidents while under the influence of alcohol are liable to pay for any damage they cause. However, liability can also be extended to other parties as well, who might be considered negligent.

How Much is My Case Worth?

Victims of drunk driving accidents can file a lawsuit to help them recover any incurred civil damages. Losses that result from these collisions vary greatly, and a person can be compensated for the following expenses:

1. Treatment and medical expenses.

2. Loss of consortium.
3. Physical and emotional pain and suffering.
4. Lost earnings.
5. Funeral expenditures.
6. Loss of monetary support.
7. Physical and emotional therapy.
8. Destruction of property.
9. **Punitive damages:** To punish *negligent DUI drivers*, The California Supreme Court ruled that the DUI offender can incur punitive charges as a disciplinary measure. This is because drunk drivers consciously get behind the wheel on their own volition and deliberately endanger the lives, health, and property of others. The California law provides for victims of DUI incidents to be awarded restitution payments for the losses incurred.

An injury lawsuit is a form of civil case that is filed by the victim of a DUI incident or their loved ones, in the event of a fatality. The purpose of doing this is to seek compensation for the damages incurred. A civil case could be your only option when you are attempting to seek compensation for the incurred medical bills, physical and emotional pain, and property damage among other claims.
