California Pedestrian Injured at Construction Site Laws

When you're injured by a forklift, you can be left with some substantial medical costs. You may lose time at work or have long-term physical damage. Someone will need to be liable for these costs; otherwise, you're going to end up paying them out of your own pocket.

Construction companies have insurance to deal with exactly this type of issue, but that doesn't mean they will immediately pay out. Further, you will need to show who was ultimately liable for your accident, and often this requires showing specific acts of negligence.

How Are Pedestrians Injured by Forklifts?

Up to <u>25% of forklift accidents are caused by improper training</u>. If employees are improperly trained on safety protocols, they can easily cause damage to pedestrian, and the company may be found liable for this. However, improper training isn't the only type of negligence commonly found in forklift accidents. Forklift accidents could also occur due to *mechanical failure* of the forklift itself, which would lead to a product liability issue. In this case, it would be the manufacturer who might be liable or any accidents.

Finally, a forklift accident could also occur due to *general negligence around a construction site*, such as *improperly marked areas* and additional safety hazards. All of this would need to be revealed through a thorough investigation, which legal professionals can assist with.
